

## Elingsrudåsen management, staff and support systems.

- Principal: Superiour head to the school, administrative and pedagogical responsible to the school and after school programme.
- Assistant principal and deputy heads: In charge of leading form teachers and their students. They report to- and cooporate in team, in lead of the principal.
- Form teacher: Every class has its own form teacher. They are in the lead of planning and performing educational content for their students and they collaborate in team with teaching staff members. School assistants assist students with special needs.
- PPT (Pedagogical and psychological services): Consults and investigates if children have special needs in terms of extra support or organisation in their psychological and cognitive development.
- Other services: Health services (school nurse and Osloentist,) childrens services.

## Group combination

- The process starts in January.
- Exchange of information with kindergardens.
- A complex process that takes time.
- We thrive to meet all needs.
- Class memberships will be published the first week of August.

#### Criterias in numerical orders:

- 1. Children with special needs.
- 2. The kindergardens evaluations, exchanged information(ex. vulnerable children, attended behaviour and language skills.)
- 3. Exchange of information from the kindergarden.
- 4. Observations from the pre-school day and the first days in the after school programme "skoleklar."
- 5. Multilingual students
- 6. Equal numbers of boys and girls.
- 7. The students address.(for safe walking to school.)
- 8. Kindergarden(to feel safety with children they know from before.)



# How and what should your child learn?

In the Early years of school our main focus is to teach your child:

- Read, write and basic maths. Practical skills like drawing and swimming.
- Cooporation and listening to others, and express their own thoughts and opinions.
- What is significant in a good friendship.
- The school take in to consideration and builds on the knowledge the child have when they start school.

# Children learn in their own pace.

# Preparation to become a pupil:

- Take the time and read a book with your child.
- Talk about the meaning of words and sentences.
- Taking turns in board games, count and wait until its your turn.
- Teach your child to be an independent dresser.
- Independent bathroom skills.
- Become familiar with the way to and from school.
- Become familiar with the school yard and local area.





## All students must feel safe and secure.

- All children should have a sense of belonging and to feel that they take part in a community.
- All adults have a legal commitment to make sure that all children are taken care of at all times.
- If your child does not feel safe or express that he-she do not thrive, please notify the school.





## A safe school environment- a legal commitment to act.

- A legal commitment to act: All school employees is obligated to pay attention to childrens well being in school. The school has a legal responsibility to provide a safe environment for students well being. The school is committed to make an effort to prevent bullying and investigate all suspicion or knowledge of a child who does not feel safe or thrive in school.
- An action plan: the school has a legal commitment to provide a plan that describes how they intend to work to prevent, discover and handle bullying and other violations.



## Student development

- The school provides feedback on social and cognitive development.
- There are two student- parent- teacher conversations within a school year.
- There are two parenting meetings per school year.
- 1st graders have their parenting meeting shortly after the school starts.

## If your child has special needs.

- Special needs education
  - We can provide special needs education, that is in addition to the ordinary curriculum.
  - The student get a personafied curriculum that is designed to meet their needs.
  - This education is provided by a special needs tutor in a small group and sometimes in a different school, depending on the needs.
- "Særskilt språkopplæring- SNO"
  - For multilangual children who needs to expand their Norwegian language skills.



### Sami education

- Children with Sami background can get education in the written or oral Sami language.
- Children who has a Sami background can get education in Sami in Nedre Bekkelaget skole or on-line tutoring.
- If ten students or more want a Sami education, they have a legal right to be provided with a full time educational offer in Sami.





### Absence and permission to leave

<u>Invalid absence:</u> Example: When the school has not been notified that you are going on holiday without a permission to leave during days of school.

- The school should be informed immediately.
- Valid absence: example: Sick leave that has been reported to school.
- After 5 days of sickness: Your form teacher will notify you about how many days your child has been away from school.
- After 10 days: Our wellfare counsellor will arrange a meeting to discuss how the school can help.

### Permission to leave:

Your form teacher can grant one day per semester. All other leave permissions is to be applied for to the principal. You can find the application form on our schools web site.



## Important upcoming dates:

- The after school progarmme "skoleklar" opens 2nd of August.
- The first day of school in the new semester is 21st of August.
- > The school starts at 8.30 am 1.30 pm
- Class membership for your child will be availabele to you approximately a week before school starts.





# The after school programme (AKS)

- Is an extended social activity before and after school.
- Offered to students from 1st grade-4th grade, and to students up to 7th grade who has special needs.
- The after school programme opens 2nd of August.
- You apply on-line. You will find the link on the schools web page.
- The city of Oslo offers free, part time enrolment, in the after school programme for all 1st graders.
